GALA FEATURE CRITERIA

- 1) Skater must have qualified for:
 - Sectionals (feature spots are available based on highest placements at Sectionals)
- 2) OR skater must have qualified for:
 - Skate Ontario Provincial Championships (feature spots are available based on highest placements at the Skate Ontario Provincial Championships)
- OR skater must have most tests passed on test days (April 2018-February 2019 inclusive); tie breaker will be determined by FreeSkate tests passed (excludes qualified sectional competitors)
- 4) OR skater must be retiring from skating in their final BSC season to pursue their future endeavours.
- 5) OR skater demonstrates a unique discipline, artistic ability or achievement.
- 6) <u>AND</u> skater must represent the BSC and <u>cannot</u> have 2 features (skater can choose 1 of the 2)

*PLEASE NOTE: "TYPE" of feature (ie. solo, duet, trio, quartet, lead etc.), will be determined by BSC Coaches & Gala Director while considering the following:

- Achievement
- Commitment/Dedication
- Opportunity
- Representation
- Inclusivity

^{*}Any exceptions to the above must be approved by Gala Director.
